

FADE IN:

INT. STUDIO ROOM - DAY

Standard interview set up. One on one, cuts between each character. [CARD: Name].

EMMA

Anna scrolls through a lengthy group chat

OLIVIA

I just got a feeling it wasn't the kind of question you could say no to.

EMMA

Do you

ANNA

Want to

OLIVIA

Go to Disney World?

PICTURE: A quintet smiles in front of Cinderella's castle. Only the woman in the center, CHARITY ROSE, looks truly happy.

V.O.

From the people who brought you, I Was A Bridesmaid, Living with IBS, and The Goop Story...

People sit down and get mic'd up with hair and makeup done. Preparing for the interview.

V.O. (CONT'D)

...comes a new story, The Tale of Disney Adults.

[CARD: Dr. Brad Bluth, Department of Sociohomocetaphiliogy Studies, UNC]

DR. BRAD BLUTH

Each year more than 5 million women fall into this type of cult.

(MORE)

DR. BRAD BLUTH (CONT'D)
They prey on vulnerable groups like
old college roommates and

CHARITY ROSE (CONT'D)

OLIVIA

I'm feeling a little tired, I'll meet you guys later.

CHARITY ROSE

Oh. No problem. Olivia, can I speak with you alone for a second?

Charity grabs Olivia by the shoulder and smiles at the rest of the group. They exit the room to the confusion of everyone else. We hear the sound of yelling and a clipboard smacking.

INT. STUDIO ROOM - DAY

GEORGE

I don't have many memories at Animal Kingdom because I was drugged (beat) by myself. I had no choice, these women were terrorizing the animals.

PICTURE: Goofy tries to walk away from the group but they keep pulling him back for more selfies.

DR. BRAD BLUTH

As with all cults, there is a financial element.

OLIVIA

I spent \$300 on food just in Epcot. Charity Rose told me the food had real fairy dust. Turns out fairy dust is another word for laxatives. While everybody was drinking around the world, I was taking shits worldwide.

ANNA

Then the gift shops. More ears, more shirts, more character bags. There was all this limited edition stuff. Like, who needs a \$9500 Dumbo jeweled figurine? And what's so funny about the pins?

EXT. DISNEY WORLD - DAY

PARK WORKER

INT. STUDIO ROOM - DAY

GEORGE

The final ritual was the most demeaning. We had to pay respects to Walt Disney's dead frozen body.

EXT. DISNEY WORLD - DAY

Charity Rose sings a very poorly done operatic rendition of Can You Feel the Love Tonight. George, Olivia, Emma, and Anna are forced to sing back up. George does a genuinely good ad-lib.

INT. STUDIO ROOM - DAY

OLIVIA

And then, all of sudden, it was over. But some good came out of it.

We see that Prince Philip is sitting beside Anna. [CARD: Prince Philip]. She puts her arm around him.

OLIVIA (CONT'D)

Don't worry. Our Disney wedding is going to be so chill.
